St Paul's Pre-Prep polo shirt – green with red sleeves with the School Crest
St Paul's green shorts with velcro pockets

For winter - St Paul's Pre-Prep tracksuit top and St Paul's green tracksuit pants

PREPARATORY SCHOOL

DAY UNIFORM – Girls and Boys

St Paul's School red polo shirt with green sleeves with the School Crest, dark green shorts with velcro pockets, green St Paul's ankle socks, solid black joggers with velcro closure
St Paul's green broad brimmed hat
For winter - St Paul's green track suit may be worn over the School uniform
Sports events - House t-shirt as supplied by the School Retail Shop

JUNIOR SCHOOL – YEARS 1-3

DAY UNIFORM – Girls and Boys

St Paul's School red polo shirt with the School Crest, dark green shorts with velcro pockets, green St Paul's ankle socks, solid black joggers (may be lace up or velcro closure)
St Paul's green broad brimmed hat
For winter - St Paul's green track suit may be worn over the School uniform.
Sports events - House t-shirt as supplied by the School Retail Shop
(Ingpen – blue, Klein – green, Rudd – red, Thiele – yellow)

JUNIOR SCHOOL – YEARS 4-6

GIRLS - DAY UNIFORM

Short-sleeved green striped uniform dress
(Dresses and skirts are to be worn with the hem line sitting just above the knee)
White "turn-down" socks
Black, low-heeled, polished leather, lace-up shoes
Boat/Deck shoes with side laces are not allowed
Skateboard-type shoes or runners are not allowed
Girls' School tie
School/House badges
School green broad brimmed hat (day wear only)
Green bike pants may be worn under the dress where appropriate
Green Jumper
Hair ribbon in solid colour (red, green or white)

BOYS - DAY UNIFORM

Short-sleeved green striped shirt
Tailored grey shorts
Black leather belt with buckle
Long grey School socks
Black, low-heeled, polished leather, lace-up shoes
Boat/Deck shoes with side laces are not allowed
Skateboard-type shoes or runners are not allowed
School tie (Terms 2 and 3)
School/House badges
School green broad brimmed hat (day wear only)
Green Jumper

MIDDLE SCHOOL & SENIOR SCHOOL YEARS 7 – 12

GIRLS – FORMAL WEAR

Formal Wear may be worn as Day Uniform – but never the reverse

Grey skirt

(Dresses and skirts are to be worn with the hem line sitting just below the knee)

Short-sleeved green striped blouse

Girls' green School tie (or senior tie)

Grey college-weight stockings (or short, plain white "turn-down" socks if at School)

Black, low-heeled, polished leather, lace-up shoes

Boat/Deck shoes with side laces are not allowed

Skateboard-type shoes or runners are not allowed

School blazer (jumper, not hoodie, may be worn under blazer)

(Blazer is compulsory to and from School from the beginning of Term 2 until the end of Term 3)

School green hat or House Cap

School/House badges

Hair ribbon in solid colour (red, green or white)

BOYS - FORMAL WEAR

Formal Wear may be worn as Day Uniform – but never the reverse

Long grey trousers, with black leather belt with buckle

Short-sleeved green striped shirt

School tie (or senior tie)

Long grey School socks

Black, low-heeled, polished leather, lace-up shoes

Boat/Deck shoes with side laces are not allowed

Skateboard-type shoes or runners are not allowed

School blazer (jumper may be worn under blazer)

School grey hat or House Cap

GIRLS – DAY WEAR

Short-sleeved green striped uniform dress

(Dresses and skirts are to be worn with the hem line sitting just below the knee)

Girls' green School tie (or senior tie)

Short, plain white "turn-down" socks

Black, low-heeled, polished leather, lace-up shoes

Boat/Deck shoes with side laces are not allowed

Skateboard-type shoes or runners are not allowed

School blazer (optional) (jumper, not hoodie, may be worn under blazer)

(Blazer is compulsory to and from School from the beginning of Term 2 until the end of Term 3)

School green hat or House Cape

School/House badges

Hair ribbon in solid colour (red, green or white)

BOYS - DAY WEAR

Short or long grey trousers, with black leather belt with buckle

Short-sleeved green striped shirt

School tie (or senior tie) to and from School

(School tie optional in School in Terms 1 and 4 if wearing grey shorts)

(School tie to be worn at all times by all boys from the start of Term 2 until the end of Term 3)

Long grey School socks

Black, low-heeled, polished leather, lace-up shoes

Boat/Deck shoes with side laces are not allowed

Skateboard-type shoes or runners are not allowed

School Blazer (optional with long trousers) (jumper may be worn under blazer)

(Blazer is compulsory to and from School from the beginning of Term 2 until the end of Term 3)

School grey hat or House Cap

School/House badges

Year 12: Senior jersey may be worn whilst at School, with the exception of Assembly and other designated formal occasions

Sports Uniform: Consists of green shorts, all-purpose white shirt or House shirt, white sports socks, sports shoes and a School sports hat for outside activities. It is to be worn in Physical Education lessons and may be worn on other occasions as advised. School tracksuit or hoodie to be worn if it is cool. Other jackets are not allowed.

Bags: All students must use the regulation, ergonomically designed School bag (backpack), which can be purchased from the Retail Shop. Met North Tour Bags can be used as a PE bag.

School/House badges: Maximum of three may be worn, but charity badges can be worn in addition to this when they are active.

Blazer

It is policy of the School that all students in the Middle and Senior School own a blazer. The blazer must be worn as an outer garment of winter uniform, to and from school, from the beginning of Term 2, until the end of Term 3.

This includes students walking or cycling to school, using public transport and those who arrive in private vehicles. Blazers will be worn to house period. Students may choose to remove them after this period. Ties must be worn at all times when wearing a blazer.

School Bags

All students in Years Prep–12 are required to use the regulation School bag (backpack), ergonomically designed, which can be purchased from the Retail Shop. All students in Prep to Year 12 MUST have a St Paul's bag (backpack) for carrying things to school each day and a St Paul's sports bag for carrying sports clothing for Phys Ed and/or sports events. Bags (backpacks) should have names marked clearly on the outside.

Excursions Policy

- Where appropriate, students will wear the normal day uniform including hats.
- If the excursion involves outdoor activities then the required uniform is the St Paul's green multi-purpose shirt, St Paul's green Phys Ed shorts, St Paul's white sports socks and clean joggers.
- If the excursion requires protection of the legs then St Paul's tracksuit pants or jeans may be worn. As advised.
- For cool days a standard school jumper with formal uniform or a St Paul's School tracksuit top or hoodie may be worn over the multi-purpose shirt.
- Junior School students will wear the St Paul's green broad brimmed hat and sun protection cream and sunglasses should be used where circumstances require.
- If a bag is required to carry lunch and other requirements it must be a St Paul's bag.

Phys Ed

For Phys Ed classes in Years Prep to 3 the students will wear their normal day uniform and will not be required to change.

In Years 4 to 6 whenever a Phys Ed period is time-tabled (other than swimming in the School Pool) students will change at the break preceding the class into House T-shirts (House T-shirts are preferable but the green multi-purpose shirt may also be worn), St Paul's green Phys Ed shorts, St Paul's sports socks and clean joggers with non marking soles for indoor use and use on tennis/ basketball courts. Sun protection cream will be provided and should be used on all occasions. The St Paul's green broad brimmed hat should also be worn on all occasions. Green bike pants may be worn under the Phys Ed shorts, by both boys and girls, when it is appropriate for the activity happening at the time. E.g. Gymnastics.

For swimming a St Paul's Rash Vest must be worn. Swimming togs should be worn but may be other than St Paul's green togs. Girls should wear a one-piece swimming costume. BOARD SHORTS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR WEARING AT FORMAL PHYS ED CLASSES. Suitable sun protection cream will be supplied and should be used as required. St Paul's green broad brimmed hats are required when out of the water.

School Policy for Spectators at School events:

If a St Paul's School student is attending a sports or other event as a spectator (e.g. if a younger or older brother or sister is competing) then he or she must be dressed in a recognisable St Paul's School uniform – either normal day uniform or the appropriate sports uniform. This applies equally to Junior School students attending Middle and Senior School events and Middle and Senior School students attending Junior School events.

School Camps

When on School Camps children wear good neat casual clothes rather than school uniform. The clothing requirements for each camp will be spelt out in the information sent out for each camp. Students in Prep – Year 9 are required to wear a St Paul’s Rash Vest when participating in water activities outside the School for Sun Safe reasons and for identification purposes.

Some Rules about Uniforms

1. When students leave the classroom at the end of the day they should be wearing their uniform correctly.
2. If you are visiting a shopping centre or other places after you leave school, your uniform should still be worn correctly, especially ties should be on, socks pulled up and shirts tucked in.
3. If you have been at a Phys Ed lesson, including swimming during Period 5 you must change back into proper day uniform to go home from school, unless you are attending an authorised School sports practice on the School grounds.
4. After swimming trials or swimming carnivals, e.g. House Carnival you must have a green multi-purpose shirt, green Phys Ed shorts, white sports socks and joggers to change in to for travelling home. If you do not have the sports uniform you must change into day uniform. It is inappropriate to leave the pool and to travel home while still dressed in swimming gear.
5. If you travel by public transport you must always travel in normal day uniform. This rule applies equally to travel following a sports practice as to travel at the end of the School day.

Junior School Uniform Requirements

Following are the details of St Paul’s School Junior School Uniform requirements for the great variety of school activities. It is the School’s desire that every student be properly attired in the full, correct uniform at all times. We would seek the support of all parents (and students) for the efforts of the staff to see that the correct uniform is being worn in a way which reflects credit on the School, its staff and its students at all times.

Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly named.

Day Uniform – Prep

- Also worn when representing the School for Debating, Public Speaking, Chess, and Tournament of Minds.
- Tracksuit tops are only to be worn for sporting events and are not part of the School day uniform.
- This is also the formal uniform for special occasions such as the Cathedral Service and the Celebration of Achievement.

Winter Uniform Additions

Long, grey trousers are available from the Retail Shop. There are very few days in winter when our climate becomes cold enough for it to be necessary for them to be worn.

Beige (skin coloured) tights are available for winter wear from the Retail Shop. Girls should wear them with their white ankle socks so that it doesn’t appear as if they are wearing stockings and also if they get hot later in the day and wish to take them off they will have socks to wear. Girls are NOT encouraged to wear them. There are very few days in winter when our climate becomes cold enough for it to be necessary to wear them.

SPORTS UNIFORMS – Junior School

Basketball

St Paul's TAS Basketball singlet with TAS Basketball shorts, PE socks and clean joggers appropriate for the sport, but with non-marking soles for indoor use. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Cricket

St Paul's TAS sports shirt, St Paul's red/white cap. Cricket whites (not available from Retail Shop), Cricket shoes and cricketer's protective box.

Cross-Country/Athletics

St Paul's TAS Cross-Country/Athletics singlet, St Paul's TAS Cross Country/Athletics shorts, St Paul's red/white cap, PE socks and clean joggers appropriate for the sport. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Football

St Paul's football jersey, shorts and socks, soccer boots, shin pads and mouth-guard. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Hockey

St Paul's TAS sports shirt (sleeveless), St Paul's green shirt, St Paul's rugby socks, shin pads and appropriate shoes for the sport. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Netball

St Paul's TAS sports shirt (sleeveless), St Paul's green skirt, PE socks, green visor and clean joggers appropriate for the sport. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Rugby Union

St Paul's rugby jersey, shorts and socks, rugby boots and a mouth-guard are required. If a tracksuit is worn it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Swimming

Black swimming togs, St Paul's swimmers cap and a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie if required.

Tennis

St Paul's TAS sport shirt, BOYS: St Paul's white shorts, GIRLS: St Paul's green skirt, PE socks, St Paul's red/white cap and clean joggers appropriate for the sport, with non-marking soles. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Touch Football

St Paul's red/white cap, St Paul's TAS sport shirt, green PE shorts and clean joggers appropriate for the sport. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

SPORTS UNIFORMS – Middle/Senior School

Basketball

St Paul's TAS Basketball singlet with TAS Basketball shorts, PE socks and clean joggers appropriate for the sport, but with non-marking soles for indoor use. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Cricket

St Paul's TAS sports shirt, St Paul's red/white cap. Cricket whites (not available from Retail Shop), cricket shoes and cricketer's protective box.

Cross-Country/Athletics

St Paul's TAS Cross-Country/Athletics singlet, St Paul's TAS Cross Country/Athletics shorts, St Paul's red/white cap, PE socks and clean joggers appropriate for the sport. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Hockey

St Paul's TAS sport shirt (sleeveless), St Paul's green shirt, St Paul's rugby socks, shin pads and appropriate shoes for the sport. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Netball

St Paul's TAS sport shirt (sleeveless), St Paul's green skirt, PE socks, green visor and clean joggers appropriate for the sport. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Rugby Union

St Paul's rugby jersey, shorts and socks, rugby boots and a mouth-guard are required. If a tracksuit is worn it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Football

St Paul's football jersey, shorts and socks, soccer boots, shin pads and mouth-guard. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit.

Swimming

Black swimming togs, St Paul's swimmers cap and a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie if required.

Tennis

St Paul's TAS sport shirt, BOYS: St Paul's white shorts, GIRLS: St Paul's green skirt, PE socks, St Paul's red/white cap and clean joggers appropriate for the sport, with non-marking soles. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.

Volleyball

St Paul's TAS sports shirt, green PE shorts, PE socks and clean joggers appropriate for the sport with non-marking soles for indoor use. If a tracksuit is required it must be a St Paul's tracksuit or regulation hoodie.
