



Indigenous Student Scholarship Application Form



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Introduction

The Bremha Foundation exists to provide Scholarship funding for members of the community with Indigenous heritage who may not have the financial means. Students will be provided with an excellent education and the capacity to develop and apply knowledge to exercise influence and make meaningful life-long contributions to their communities.

Full or part Scholarships are offered to indigenous students to cover the cost of tuition at Bremha's partner school, St Paul's School.

To be eligible for a Bremha full or part Scholarship you need to be:

- an Indigenous Australian;
- enthusiastic about attending school;
- put in their best effort to their studies and participate in the School's Extra-Curricular Program;
- likely to successfully complete Year 12;
- in financial need;
- have parents/family that demonstrate support for and enrolment at St Paul's School, its ethos and expectations of students.

What does the Scholarship cover?

Depending on the family's level of financial need a Bremha Foundation Scholarship will cover 20% to 100% of the cost of tuition at St Paul's School from Year 7 to the end of Year 12. Students wishing to enter the School at another grade level may be considered.

Additional expenses, such as laptop, and uniforms should be paid by the family.

Conditions for the family

As the student's parent/guardian you must support the following to be eligible:

- Support your child's full attendance at St Paul's School;
- Support the ethos of St Paul's School and its expectations, including the expectation that your child must put in their best effort to their studies and attain at least their Queensland Certificate of Education if not entrance to tertiary study and/or an entrepreneurial pathway.
