You will be receiving learning activities from school through our Seesaw Platform. Each day your child's classroom and specialist teachers will be setting activities and tasks for the children to do throughout the day.

You can access your child's seesaw learning journal on an iOS, Android and web device.

For iOS and Android devices: Please download the Seesaw CLASS app

For Computer devices (recommended for students in years 3-6):

Please access Seesaw via: <u>https://web.seesaw.me/</u>

You should receive a Class QR code via email from your child's teacher to allow your child to log into their journal. For privacy reasons, please do not share this code with anyone outside of your household. When we return to school, the code will be reset for classroom use only.

When receiving the learning activities from school, it is important to set up a good daily routine to complete lessons and share learning experiences at home. Teachers will endeavour to provide engaging online and hands on activities that align with learning that would otherwise occur in the classroom.

Other tasks like home reading, mathletics, sight word and vocabulary activities will be encouraged and collected upon return to school.

Alternatively, Seesaw actually set up a 'families' page on their website, which is a wonderful tool for our families to access. I would probably refer to this information or to the link as much as possible, as they have done all the hard work for us, and have a team of staff that assist with any problems they might have with the platform at home. There is a <u>helpful FAQ</u> page there as well.
