

GENERAL INFORMATION

🕐 Program

The St Paul's Vacation Program is available for a minimum of 2 weeks up to 6 weeks. Each week consists of English lessons, activities and one full-day and one half-day excursion. All excursions are booked at the discretion of the School. In 2022, excursions proceeding will be dependent on the minimum number of students being met.

? Homestay

Students will live in homestay accommodation for the duration of the course. The Homestay program is run 100% by St Paul's School. All meals are provided by the homestay family.

? Transport

In most cases the homestay family will transport students to and from School. Alternatively, permission may be given for students to travel by public transport if accompanied by another St Paul's student (this is at the discretion of St Paul's School). The costs for transport are met by the homestay family.

Payment Deadlines

All monies should be received no later than four weeks prior to the commencement of the Program.

Period Specialist English Classes/Integration

Classes will be assigned depending on language proficiency. Integration with mainstream students is available in House Tutor Group each morning.

Airport Pick Up & Drop Off

Airport pick-up will be arranged by the School. Details will be forwarded to you on receipt of flight arrival times. Students will be taken to their homestay or to School, depending on the arrival time and the number of students. The School will arrange for airport drop-off when the students are returning home. This is a free service to and from Brisbane airport only.)

🥐 Uniforms

At the start of the program, students will be given one St Paul's School polo shirt and one St Paul's School Cap, which they may wear with neat casual shorts, skirts or trousers. This can be worn each day, or for excursions only. Students are welcome to wear the formal uniform from their home country during their visit or purchase additional uniform items from the St Paul's Retail Shop. Students should also bring clothing suitable for outdoors, including footwear (eg joggers), a hat and swimming costume.

? Insurance

Private health and travel insurance must be arranged by the family for the duration of each student's stay in Australia.

? Refunds

Cancellations will be accepted up to one week prior to the commencement of the Program. There will be no refund for cancellations made after that time.
